

# APPLE VALLEY SCULPTURE COMPETITION

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENTERING THE HUON VALLEY MID-WINTER FESTIVAL 2019: APPLE VALLEY SCULPTURE COMPETITION (AVSC)

AVSC is open to all forms, materials and large sizes of sculpture. The exhibition site accommodates illuminated large weather resistant sculpture created for outdoor display.

### 1. APPLICATION AND NOTIFICATION

Applications Entry forms are available via email from mid March 2019, and close at 5pm on 1st May 2019. Competition sculpture drop off and installation 10 – 12 July 2019.

- You are encouraged to submit your entry outline as early as possible.
- All outdoor sculptures must be all weather.
- All sculptures must be illuminated for night viewing.
- Late or incomplete works will not be accepted.
- Outdoor sculptures requiring a plinth must be provided by the artist.
- If sculptures require provision for power, this must be discussed 2 weeks prior to drop off.

### 2. APPLE VALLEY SCULPTURE COMPETITION PRIZE AWARDS

First Prize - \$3,000  
Second Prize - \$2000  
People's Choice Award - \$1000

All awards are non-acquisitive.

Prizes awarded and Judges' decisions are final.

### 3. SITE AVAILABILITY

Final site selection for all sculptures in the competition is the decision of the Curator.

### 4. SITE SIGNAGE

Your name and the title of your sculpture will be listed on a site plaque next to your sculpture. Artists are not permitted to have additional signage, commercial logos, advertising or websites on their works.

### 5. TRANSPORTATION

Artists are responsible for the transportation of their sculptures to and from the competition site, installation /deinstallation and for arranging the removal of all packaging materials from the site.

### 6. DELIVERY, INSTALLATION & DE-INSTALLATION

Delivery of works will commence Wednesday 10 July 2019 through to Friday 12 July 2019, to enable site allocation.

# APPLE VALLEY SCULPTURE COMPETITION

De-installation will commence on Monday 15 July 2019 and all sculptures are to be removed by the exhibiting artist not later than 5:00pm Tuesday 16 July 2019, unless otherwise agreed with the Curator.

Due to the need to return the grounds to their normal condition and if the sculpture is not removed by 5:00pm Tuesday 16 July 2019 the AVSC will arrange to have the sculpture removed and the artist will be required to pay costs of such removal and subsequent storage or disposal.

The responsibility for installing and de-installing the sculpture(s) is the artists. Please bring your own tools and extra help if needed.

On arrival, registration will need to be completed.

## **AVSC ARTISTS EXHIBIT AT THEIR OWN RISK**

The exhibition does not have an accidental and malicious damage insurance policy to cover the sculptures. All such risks in the exhibition of sculptures remain with the artist at all times, irrespective of whether the work is being handled by a member of the exhibition staff; as well as during the installation and de-installation process.

By signing the entry form artists authorize the exhibition staff to move their sculpture or remove it from the site for reasons, including but not limited to public safety, damage or potential damage the sculpture.

All selected artists are to be contactable via a daytime contact number or mobile phone number during the exhibition.

## **ACSC HAS THE RIGHT TO REPRODUCE IMAGES OF THE SCULPTURE TO BE EXHIBITED**

provided by the artist for pre-selection and any images of the work in the exhibition for the exhibition catalogue, publicity, or archival purposes in any manner connected with the exhibition, including any promotion for Huon Valley Mid Winter Festival 2019 and 2020.

Should the artist wish to use images of his/her work taken at the exhibition for any promotional purposes including websites, opening invitations or photos submitted to publications please credit the exhibition and the Huon Valley Mid Winter Festival 2019 and establish a link to our official website if possible.

The terms of this agreement apply into the future and are not limited to the year of exhibition.
